To be eligible to apply for General Skilled Migration (GSM) in the nominated occupation, you must provide evidence of either English language proficiency or evidence of the completion of the Skilled Migration Internship Program-Accounting (SMIPA).

English Language Proficiency

To be eligible to apply for GSM, applicants must provide an IELTS Academic Test Report Form (TRF) showing a band score of at least 7 in each of the four components of speaking, reading, listening and writing. This evidence would normally consist of a certified true copy of the TRF; which the IPA will then verify direct with IELTS.

OR

Skilled Migration Internship Program – Accounting (SMIPA)

To be eligible to apply for GSM, applicants must provide evidence of the completion of the SMIPA. This evidence would normally consist of certified true copies of statements of completion and other testamurs issued by approved SMIPA providers.
