
Portal maintenance and issues


- > Regularly check the System and maintenance issues page, accessed via the ato.gov.au homepage

- > Report system issues by calling 13 72 86 Fast Key Code 3 3






Tax agent portal dashboard

What to expect in 2015-16

Cloud software authorisation and authentication

- > We are working to streamline the way you authenticate with our systems when using Standard Business Reporting (SBR)-enabled online software (i.e. software hosted in the cloud)
- > Eliminates the need to obtain, upload or use an AUSkey if using SBR-enabled, cloud-based software.

What do the foundations offer beyond 2016

Single Touch Payroll (STP)

- > To help reduce red tape for businesses and employers we're developing Single Touch Payroll (STP)
- > Initial consultations have finished. A proposal is with Government for consideration:
 - a proposed pilot with small business in 2017
 - opportunity for early adopters to get on board from July 2017
 - businesses with 20 or more employees to transition from July 2018.
- > Discussions with software developers are continuing to explore design options for reporting payroll information

Lodgment program updates

Performance improvements

- > Income tax returns lodged on-time increased 79.9% (2010-11) to 86% (2013-14)
- > 78.6% of agents achieved lodging 75% or more returns on-time
- > 43% fewer income tax returns lodged by paper compared to 3 years ago
- > 99.3% income tax returns lodged by agents electronically
- > FBT returns lodged by paper decreased 72% over 3 years.


