The IPA Board Disciplinary Tribunal of 19 April 2013 considered the following case presented against the member:

- a) Breached clause 98(1) of the IPA Constitution as the member had been convicted by a court of law of an offence inconsistent with being a member of the IPA.
- b) Breached clause 98(2)(b) of the IPA Constitution as the member failed to observe a proper standard of professional care, skill or competence.
- c) Breached clause 98(2)(c) of the IPA Constitution as the member obtained admission to the IPA by improper means.
- d) Breached clause 98(2)(f) of the IPA Constitution as the member is guilty of conduct which is not in the best interests of the IPA.

The Tribunal determined that the member's resignation, tendered to the Tribunal, would be accepted subject to the following conditions:

- a) The member will not reapply for membership with the IPA;
- b) Reference to membership of the IPA is removed from the member's website and any other material; and
- c) Costs of \$550.00 are imposed.
