
The NIA Investigations Review Officer and the NIA Investigations Officer have resolved that:

- (a) Mr. Cooper had a case to answer for having breached clause 98(2)(c) of the NIA Constitution in that it is alleged he obtained admission to this Institute by improper means in that he did not disclose in his application for membership that he had prior convictions relevant to determining admission to membership of this Institute; and
- (b) Mr. Cooper had a case to answer for having breached clause 98(2)(f) of the NIA Constitution in that it is alleged the abovementioned is conduct that is not in the best interests of the Institute.

Tribunal Decision

The Tribunal resolved that there was a case to answer under both sections 98(2)(c) and 98(2)(f) of the NIA Constitution.

The Tribunal further resolved that Mr. Cooper's membership is forfeited and costs of \$500.00 are applied, payable in 30 days.
